This form is used to negate verbs in the past tense; i.e. to say things like “I didn’t” do something or something “was not” some way.

- 집 구하다 → 집 구하기
to house hunt → house **hunt**ing
- 미국에 가다 → 미국에 가기
to go to America → **going** to America

Verb
+
-지 않았다

This form is used to negate verbs in the past tense; i.e. to say things like “I didn’t” do something or something “was not” some way.

- 많다 → **많지 않았다.**
to be many → There **were not** many.
- 한국에 가다 → 한국에 **가지 않았다.**
to go to Korea → I **didn't** go to Korea.

Noun
+
-에게도

This form is used to say ‘for this noun also,’ or ‘for this noun, too.’ The ‘에게’ means ‘to/for’ and ‘도’ means ‘also/too.’

- 우리 → 우리에게도
us → **for** us **too**
- 사람 → 사람에게도
person(s) → **for** person(s) **too**
