## GRAMMAR FOCUS

**Verb**  
+  
**-(으)ㄹ 수 있다**

This form is used to talk about the things you can do. If the verb stem ends on a vowel sound, attach -ㄹ 수 있다. If the verb stem ends on a consonant sound, attach -을 수 있다.

- 하다 → 할 수 있다.  
to do → I **can** do.
- 먹다 → 먹을 수 있다.  
to eat → I **can** eat.

**Noun**  
+  
**부터**

The 부터 particle indicates that something happens 'from' some noun. It is commonly used with times to talk about something happening 'from' that time. It is also commonly used with '시작하다' (to start) to indicate that something starts from that noun.

- 집안일 → 집안일부터  
housework → **(starting) from** the housework
- 청소기 → 청소기부터  
the vacuum → **(starting) from** the vacuum

**Verb**  
+  
**-아/어보지 뭐**

This is a casual expression used to express a certain feeling - that of when you're resigned to doing something else. This is similar to saying something like, "Oh well, I guess I'll do X instead, then" in English.

- 빨래를 해보지 뭐!  
**Oh well, I guess** I'll do the laundry instead!
- 내일 다시 해보지 뭐.  
**Oh well, I guess** I'll try again tomorrow.
