Noun
+
-와/괴

If the noun ends on a consonant, use - m
m
m L.

If the noun ends on a vowel, use -와.

- 이불**과** 옷 blankets **and** clothes
- 이불 몇 개**안** 옷

a few blankets **and** some clothes

Noun + 밖에 없다

This grammar form means 'nothing but N.'

'밖에' means 'outside' and 없다 means 'not exist.' Therefore 'N밖에' literally means; 'outside of N, nothing exists,' or just; 'nothing but N.'

- 이불 몇 개와 옷밖에 없다.
 We have **nothing but** some blankets and clothes.
- 우리는 서로**밖에 없다.** We have **nothing but** each other.

Verb + -기로 했다

This grammar form is used to talk about things that you have decided to do.

- 자기로 했다.
 We decided to sleep.
- 먹기로 했다. We **decided to** eat.
- 미국으로 가**기로 했다.** We **decided to** go to America.
